Contributor Copyright Policy

The NTL Institute for Applied Behavioural Science (NTL) acting through the Editor of Practising Social Change (PSC)

And the contributor named in the attached email or letter ("Contributor")

As of the date of the attached email agree as follows:

1. This policy covers all written work undertaken by the Contributor for PSC except when the Editor of PSC agrees in writing that specific commissions are excluded.
2. The Contributor retains ownership of the underlying ideas in the article, and may adapt the material in any derivative work of which the Contributor is the author.
3. The Contributor grants NTL a permanent royalty-free licence to publish the work in connection with *Practising Social Change*. The ways NTL may do this include, but are not limited to, publication of the work in any paper and internet editions of PSC, and distribution of the work in print and in electronic form (such as PDF and HTML format), or in any other electronic format or media. This also covers inclusion of the work in online databases, news services and search archives.
4. The Contributor agrees that the above license shall be on an exclusive basis for six months following first publication, the date of which will be confirmed to the Contributor by the Editor of PSC. The Contributor shall be entitled to offer the work for publication to third parties after this period, provided only that i) the Contributor ensures that the acknowledgement "first published in *Practising Social Change*" quoting the year, appears in connection with any such re-publication and ii) the graphics NTL has provided are not used. Where possible the acknowledgement should include a link to the website of PSC www.ntl-psc.org. NTL acknowledges that this includes the right for the Contributor to resell the work to other publishers after the initial period. The Editor of PSC (acting on behalf of NTL) agrees to direct enquiries from other publishers about the work to the Contributor, and the Contributor agrees that the Editor of PSC and NTL may pass his or her contact details to other publishers for this purpose.
5. The Editor of PSC will provide the Contributor with a PDF of the article as displayed on the website of PSC and subject to the conditions of paragraph 4 above including the time period of exclusivity granted to PSC, the Contributor may display this on his or her own website or business website, provided no alterations are made to the format, substance, design, illustrations or copyright acknowledgements.
6. The Contributor warrants that all work submitted is entirely their own work (unless otherwise credited) and has not previously been published elsewhere.
7. Submission of any work by the Contributor signifies their acceptance of the terms of this policy.
8. The attached email and this policy represent the entire agreement between the parties.
